## ALTOS LAUNCHES MAJOR XENIX\* MARKETING STRATEGY

### Dealer Subscription And Software Developers Plans

SAN JOSE, CALIF., March 17-- Altos Computer Systems today announced the establishment of major new dealer/ISO software subscription and training programs aimed at encouraging the application of the XENIX<sup>TM</sup>\* operating system in the dealer marketplace. Furthermore, Altos has implemented a technical support program for software developers to aid in the porting of applications to the XENIX environment.

Called ASAP<sup>TM</sup> for Altos Software Availability Program<sup>TM</sup>, the new XENIX software subscription plan provides participating Altos dealers with: (1) a variety of carefully selected XENIX application packages on a regular, ongoing basis; (2) discounts of 30% and more on software; (3) an Altos dealer handbook containing Altos-created data sheets summarizing each application program in a consistent manner; and, (4) use of a toll-free phone number to place orders for software.

\*The XENIX<sup>TM</sup> operating system is the Microsoft implementation of the UNIX operating system. UNIX is a trademark of Bell Laboratories.

This new Altos ASAP effort also includes aid to application software developers in the form of technical support, hardware, and by providing software languages and the XENIX operating system itself.

Also being scheduled are regional training sessions for dealers on XENIX applications throughout the nation each month over the next year. The initial schedule includes Seattle in April, Chicago in May, and New York in June.

"XENIX is the most powerful operating system today with tremendous development tool capabilities," said David Jackson, Altos founder and president. "We believe the future for the dealer and ISO is directly tied to the XENIX operating system, and Altos has taken the lead in recognizing this and helping dealers make the transition."

The ASAP program offers software applications intended for use on the Altos Computer Systems multi-user 586 and 8600 microcomputer systems based on the Intel 8086 chip. The combination of the new high-speed Altos 586 microcomputer systems and the XENIX operating system, Altos believes, is the most cost-effective 16-bit XENIX system on the market.

Dealers wishing to participate in the Altos ASAP program may do so by submitting an application and an annual \$250 subscription fee. Dealer kits will be available April 15, with software shipments to begin the following month. Altos distributors will also stock and offer dealers the software packages in the ASAP plan.

Initially, the program will offer a variety of third-party software programs, for example: (1) the LEX<sup>TM</sup> word processing program from Softest, Inc. of New Jersey; (2) the UNIFY<sup>TM</sup> relational data base management system from Northern American Technology of Sacramento, CA; and (3) the Real World<sup>TM</sup> general accounting software series from MBSI of New Hampshire. Eventually, Altos expects to significantly increase its selection of software packages with regular offerings. (See attached for

All ASAP software will retain the software manufacturer's labeling, and support will be provided by the software manufacturer. In a cooperative arrangement with Altos, software vendors will also play a major part in the regional training sessions.

Larry Wilber, vice president for marketing at MBSI, a leading software manufacturer participating in the ASAP program, commented: "Training and support are the pivotal issues in the software dealer marketplace. Altos, by utilizing manufacturer's support and involving the manufacturer in the training, has accomplished a marketing coup. Furthermore, dealers gain the benefit of having Altos perform a quality control function for them."

David Jackson added: "It is not Altos' intention merely to create a lengthy index of XENIX compatible software. Instead, we will carefully create and gradually expand a select list of quality products that will help boost dealer acceptance and sales of the XENIX compatible application software."
