PURPOSE:

The 24 VDC solenoids used in Top Load and Front Load interlock systems could possibly become marginal if left energized for long periods of time. These failures have only been associated with DELTROL control solenoids model D-16-24 VDC. Although it appears to be a batch related problem and only those solenoids with 7414 date codes are suspected, the vendor can offer no traceability. Therefore, drives in the above serial number range, listed in the effectivity block, could be affected.

SYMPTOMS:

Solenoid will not pull plunger when hot.

Test:

- a) Allow drive to set in "SAFE" for approximately one hour.
- b) Turn A/C power switch off then immediately on again.
- c) If solenoid fails to pull plunger, solenoid should be changed per the following procedure.

PARTS:

1 (one) solenoid with plunger PERTEC P/N 517-0001.

SPECIAL TOOLS: None (Adapter bowl set-up tool is not required)

ADJUSTMENTS: Adjust per D3000 Manual.

Section 6-15 - Front Load interlock system Section 6-16 - Top Load interlock system

****NOTE***

Section 6-16 calls out the use of an adapter bowl set-up tool for setting the cartridge in place switches. These switches can be set using trial and error techniques, i.e., when the cartridge lock arms are in the locked position with a cartridge in place, the switch must be adjusted so that the actuator made.
