SUBJECT:

INTERMITTENT DATA ERRORS (SERVICE HINT)

PURPOSE:

Should intermittent data errors be plaguing a particular drive and all adjustments of the read/write circuitry are correct, static discharge may be the problem. On older drives, if proper P.M. (Preventive Maintenance) procedures have not been adhered to, it is likely the lubrication has aged and is not making sufficient contact. On newer drives the static discharge lubrication may have dried itself out if low humidity has been an environmental factor. In either case, the static discharge spring, located on the belt guard plate, must be relubricated.

\*\*\*NOTE\*\*\*

In the event replacement of the static discharge spring is necessary (Reference Service Letter DK-3030).

SYMPTOMS:

Intermittent data errors approximately one (1) hour after start-up, that continue to build over periods of time.

TEST

PROCEDURE:

Bring unit having data errors to the safe condition then restart. If unit does not exhibit data errors for approximately another hour, static discharge spring should be lubricated.
