Adobe Illustrator 5.5 for Silicon Graphics

What do I have?

We're sure that you will enjoy using Adobe Illustrator software and the many exciting features that this illustration and page design application offers, as well as the extra products included on the CD-ROM.

In addition to Adobe Illustrator, this product includes a selection of Type 1 fonts and several complimentary software applications: Adobe™ Type Installer, Adobe ShowPS™ and a Type On Call™ CD-ROM.

Installing the fonts and complimentary applications is optional. You may install some, all or none of them. However, because the installation instructions for Adobe Type Installer are in a PostScript™ language document, you will need to install the Adobe ShowPS software to read the document. To use the Type 1 fonts, you need to first install Adobe Type Installer.

What can I do with all the extra products?

- ▶ Use Adobe ShowPS to preview any PostScript language document.
- ▶ Use Adobe Type Installer to install, preview and browse Type 1 fonts on your UNIX system, download them to your Adobe PostScript printer and create new instances of multiple master fonts. (Of course, if you want to use the Type 1 fonts included on the Adobe Illustrator CD-ROM, you need to have Adobe Type Installer on your machine.)
- ▶ Use Type On Call to purchase additional fonts from the Adobe Type Library—which includes more than 2000 fonts.

Where do I start?

▶ To install and license Adobe Illustrator, follow the instructions in the *Adobe Illustrator Getting Started Guide*.

To install Adobe ShowPS, follow the instructions in the *Adobe ShowPS Getting Started Guide*.

A great place to begin exploring Adobe Illustrator is with the tutorial.

Use Adobe ShowPS to read it.

▶ To install Adobe Type Installer, follow the instructions in the *Adobe Type Installer Getting Started Guide*. This document is available in PostScript format in

/CDROM/typeinst/getstart.ps

Use Adobe ShowPS to read it.

To install and use any of the fonts on the CD-ROM, launch Adobe Type Installer and follow the instructions in the *Adobe Type Installer User Guide* for installing fonts.

The Adobe Type Installer User Guide is a PostScript file located in <installdir>/TypeInstaller_1.0/doc/UserGuide_TypeInst.ps
Use Adobe ShowPS to read it.

While using Adobe Type Installer, install your Type 1 fonts from the following directory:

/cdrom/adobe/*

▶ Refer to the Type On Call package for instructions on how to order additional fonts through Type On Call.

Remember, installing Adobe Type Installer, the fonts and Adobe ShowPS is optional, although we hope you'll choose to use these applications and discover their benefits.
