By the time this issue of Microminutes is distributed, we should have both the CPU boards ready for loading and the machining complete on the card cage parts. The card cage parts had many holes that needed to be drilled at precise locations. The original plan was to use an N/C machine to drill the holes. However, we were unable to obtain access to use the N/C machine without paying full labor and overhead costs. This accounted for the \$50 price on the order form. Since that time, a special fixture was made that would allow fast and accurate positioning of the holes on an ordinary drill press. The club has ordered sufficient card cages for everyone building the computer even though orders for card cages have not yet been received from everyone. The official price is still \$50, but if everyone sends in their check, there will be a very significant refund. The exact refund will depend on how many card cages are actually purchased, but the final price will be around \$15, if all are sold. So send in your order to Barry Lewis, building 90 by December 11. Those orders received after 12/11 will be charged a higher price.
